Overview of the Leonberger Sieger Show

A true Sieger Show in Europe is quite an undertaking for both exhibitors and organizers. Most Literature on the origins point to the German Shepherd dog and evaluations were based not only on structure but also demonstrated working ability.

On this side of the pond, "Sieger" or "Sieger-Style" shows are unofficial events held by breed clubs as fun, relaxed and educational events to provide owners and breeders verbal critiques and written evaluations of their dogs. Judges are usually long-time breeders who have spent years studying the breed and are extremely knowledgeable on structure and type.

Each dog is evaluated and given a score based on how closely it measures up to the "ideal dog" as described in the breed standard. The dog receives a thorough hands on examination and is assessed in a relaxed and informal manner, standing naturally, and gaiting on a loose lead. For the education of owners and spectators, the judge will usually provide a verbal assessment of each dog presented.

Both puppies and adult dogs will be divided into male and female classes.

Puppies are assessed first, and each receives a written critique and rating of Very Promising, Promising or Fair. All puppies receiving a Very Promising rating will then compete for the Most Promising Puppy Award.

Once the puppies have been evaluated the adult dogs will enter the ring. Each dog is given a thorough hands on examination and written critique and overall rating that can range from Poor to Excellent. After all the dogs have been evaluated, only the dogs rated Excellent (there can be several from the same class) are brought back into the ring together to vie for Best in Sieger Show (decided from the best male and female), Best of Opposite Sex in Sieger and Best Veteran in Sieger Show.

Classes

(divided by sex and age)

Puppy 6-12 months Youth 12-18 months

Open 18 month or older that have not received a Championship title

Specials any Leonberger that has already earned either a CKC or an AKC championship

Veteran 7 years and older

Classes are open to both altered and intact leonbergers!!

Dogs do not have to be entered in the regular classes or for exhibition only at the Specialty or All-Breed show to compete in the Sieger Show.

NOTE: Any dogs not entered in those events are not permitted at the Heritage Park site, as per CKC rules

CERTIFICATES AND ROSETTES

All dogs receiving an excellent or Very Promising grading will be awarded a certificate. Rosettes will be awarded to Best in Sieger Show, Best of Opposite in Sieger Show and Best Veteran in Sieger Show. A rosette will also be awarded to the Most Promising Puppy in Sieger Show.

SPECIAL NOTES FOR US ENTRANTS

A valid Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada.

Government regulations require this Certificate and it MUST be dated at least 30 days prior to reentry into the US.

Please check the US and Canadian Government websites for rules and regulations on bringing dog food across the border. These rules change regularly and sometimes without much notice.

- 8.3 Entries Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:
- (a) registered with the CKC;
- (b) have an Event Registration Number;
- (c) eligible for registration with the CKC;
- (49-03-13) (d) with the exception of Baby Puppy, if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN).
- 8.3.2 No person shall enter a dog in a championship show that is known to be blind (in one or both eyes), deaf, castrated or spayed or that has had its appearance changed by artificial or surgical means other than those recognized by the standard for its breed.
- 8.4 Listed Dogs
- 8.4.1 If a dog is not registered as in 8.3.1 (a) or (b) but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided:
- (a) that if born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration;
- (b) that if not born in Canada, it is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC;
- (c) that if it is a foreign-born and owned dog, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.
- 8.4.2 Entry of a listed dog at a show must be accompanied by a listing fee as set by the Board in addition to the regular entry fee.
- 8.4.3 The CKC has the right to require the owner of a listed dog to provide proof of the dog's eligibility for registration in the CKC. If it is found that the dog is not eligible, the CKC shall have the right to cancel all wins.
- 8.4.4 When a CKC registration number for a listed dog is received after the closing date and prior to the date of the show, this number may be added to the entry and noted in the marked catalogue. Listing fees will not be refunded. This then allows a dog who completes the requirement for championship status to be moved up to Specials.
